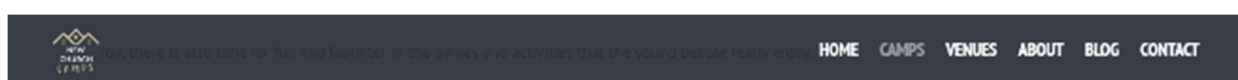


New Church Camps Website

Camps for different ages

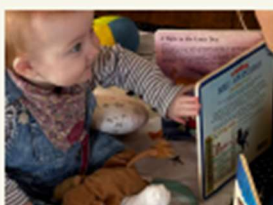
