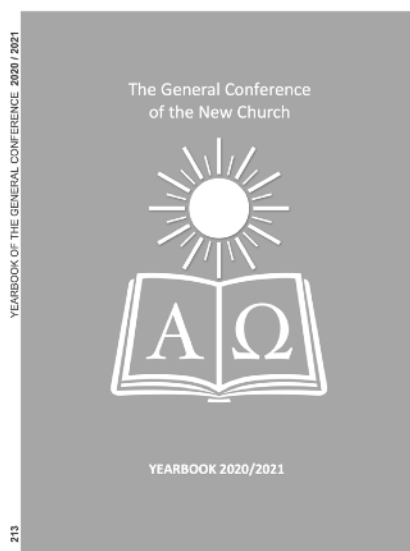
2020/21 Yearbook

Stamp Collection

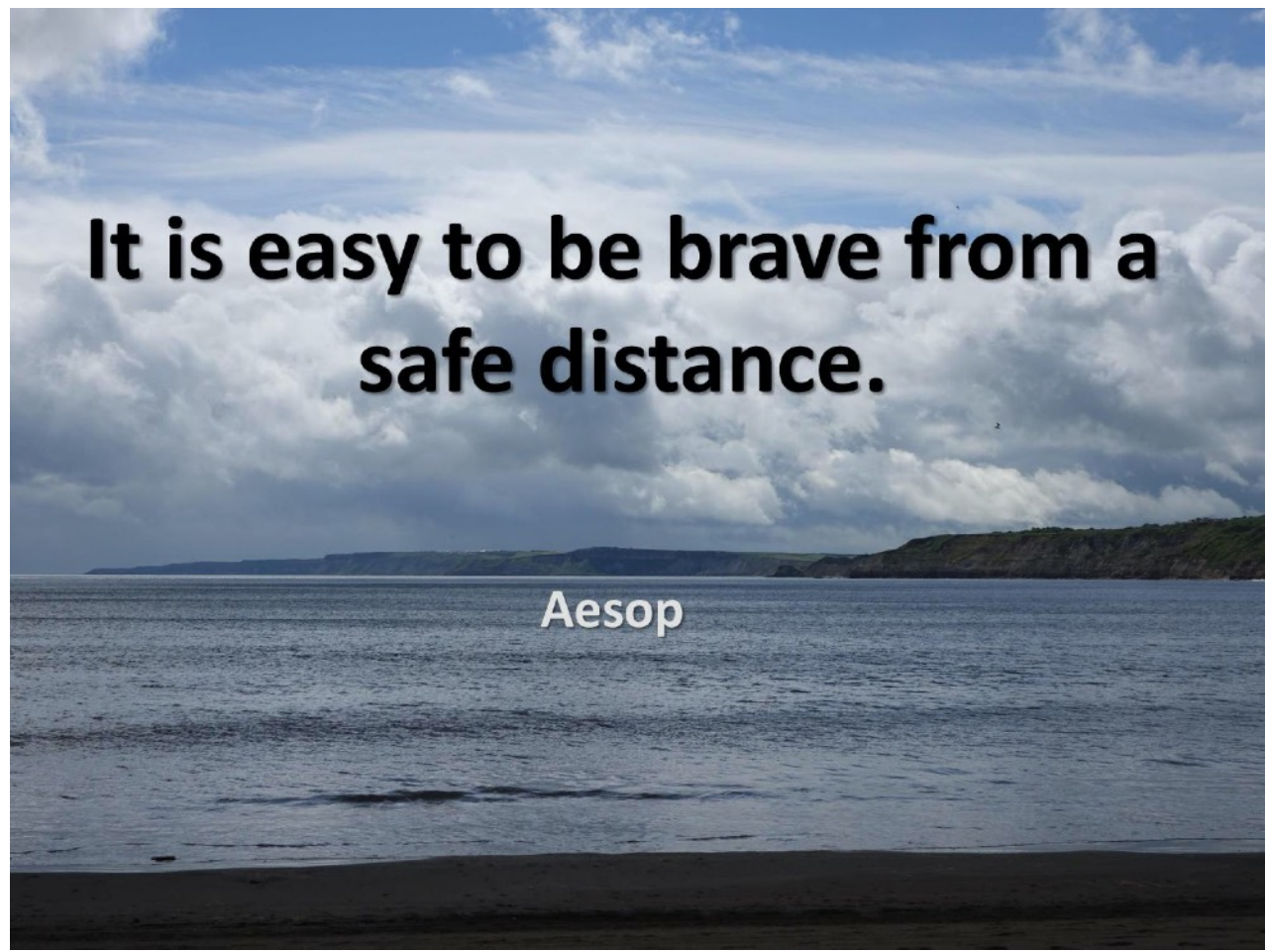
David Friend writes:
