Scam Email Warning

Gemma McLean reports:

A new email scam is doing the rounds at the moment, where a fake penalty charge notice for using your car in an electric charging area is issued. This is completely false but several people I know have received it and confessed that for a moment, they were fooled.

The tell-tale signs that it is fake are:

- * They don't use your car registration or name.
- * Genuine penalty notices are NEVER issued via email. They always come via post to the registered vehicle owner's address.

I have included a screenshot of the email below so you know what to look out for. Just ignore or delete the email if you receive it. The email itself isn't harmful to your computer - the harm would come by clicking the link and paying these scammers the money they are asking for.

There seems to have been a general increase in scam messages lately. I have received a text message purporting to be from O2 saying my bill payment failed. There is a scam link in the text that they want you to click and "update your debit card" details, which is obviously just the scammer trying to get your card information.

I have also had automated phone calls purporting to be from Amazon saying there has been fraudulent orders made on my account, which is ironic really as the phone call itself is actually the fraud! As soon as I hear the automated voice, I just hang up.

So please stay careful and be suspicious of any messages that want you to provide any sort of payment of payment information.
