Easter Sunday at Seaburn Dene

On Easter Sunday a larger than usual Congregation met at Seaburn, welcoming visiting families and friends back to the area over the Easter holidays.

It was lovely to catch up and to include so many in the service also. Many thanks to Eve and Luke for their readings from Matthew's gospel where we heard how Mary Magdalene and the other Mary found the tomb empty and were told "do not be

afraid” before later meeting Jesus himself following His resurrection, again being told “do not be afraid”.

After an Easter egg hunt around the church for eggs representing the stone rolled from the Tomb entrance and hearts representing Jesus’ love for us all, the younger members stepped to the back of the church to complete their task. Earlier in the service we had watched the Lego Easter story which retells events using Lego figures so our young people were asked to recreate the moment the two Mary’s found the tomb empty using Lego.



Their model making skills astounded us as they built a tomb with an angel at the front, the two Mary’s looking in the tomb, Jesus far away from the tomb, the crosses to the side to represent the crucifixion with trees and flowers all around also.

It was a special moment and lovely that we could share in worship in both traditional and more modern ways, all reflecting those magnificent events we remember on Easter Sunday.
