Mary was a very popular person at Annual Meetings of our church. She was a much loved, lifelong and leading member of the Bradford Society, until she had to move to a nursing home in Northamptonshire. She was a worship leader whose deep love for the Teachings of the Church shone through her services and affected people for the

better. She was a member of the Conference Council for quite a few years. She was a member of the Minutes Committee at many Conferences. For her years of service to the church and Conference, she was made an Honorary Life Member of Conference. Mary was a Governor of the New Church College and worked with Revd Mary Duckworth on a module on Worship Leading in the 1990s. She will be greatly missed.
