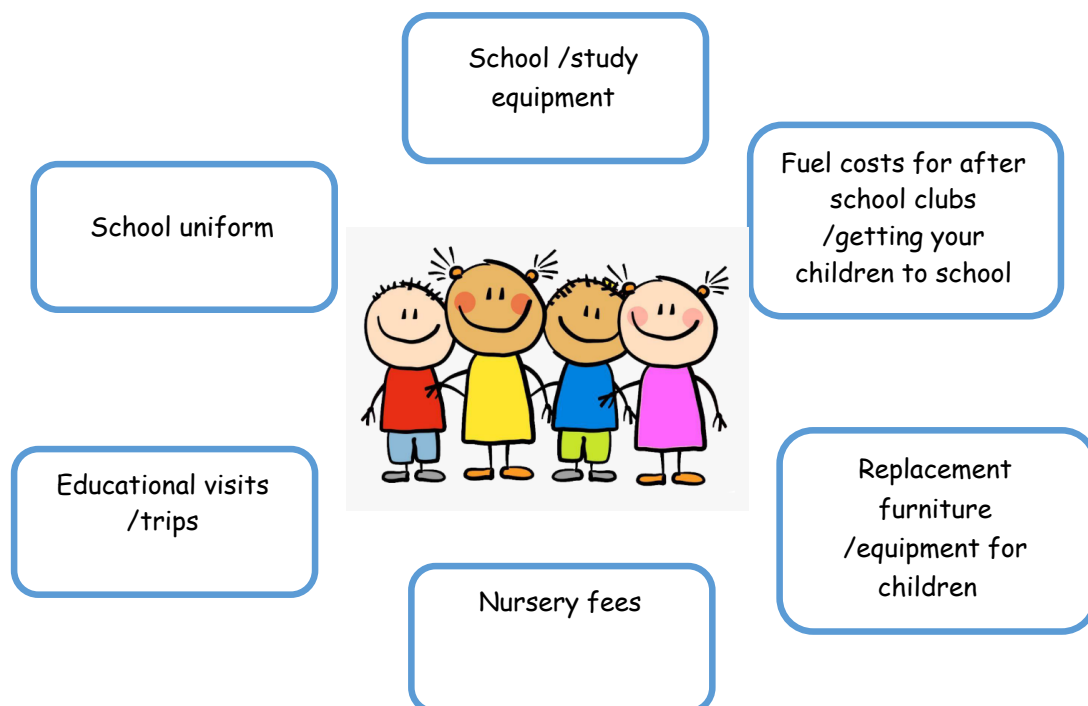
Do you have children under the age of 25?
