14	Sale of Radcliffe Church	
	The sale of Radcliffe is proving to be very complicated because of the Trust Deeds associated with the Society and the land. The Trust Deeds state that proceeds of sale must be used in the district of Radcliffe and Whitefield or within the radius of twelve miles from the premises. The only remaining Society still functioning within the twelve-mile radius is Kearsley. In order to be able to use the proceeds of sale for general use, Conference Council has been advised by our solicitors to apply to the Charity Commission for a scheme known as Cy-près.	
	We need to do this because the spirit of the original gift cannot be carried out, but the Charity Commission, if satisfied with our application, can make a scheme to provide for new purposes of a similar nature.	
	Margaret Cowie proposed to the Council that the General Conference of the New Church puts in an application to the Charity Commission to apply for the Cy-près scheme. Revd Bruce Jarvis seconded, and all present agreed and approved.	
	Resolved: That the General Conference applies to the Charity Commission for a Cy-Près scheme.
