Revd Brian Talbot's Article on Demons

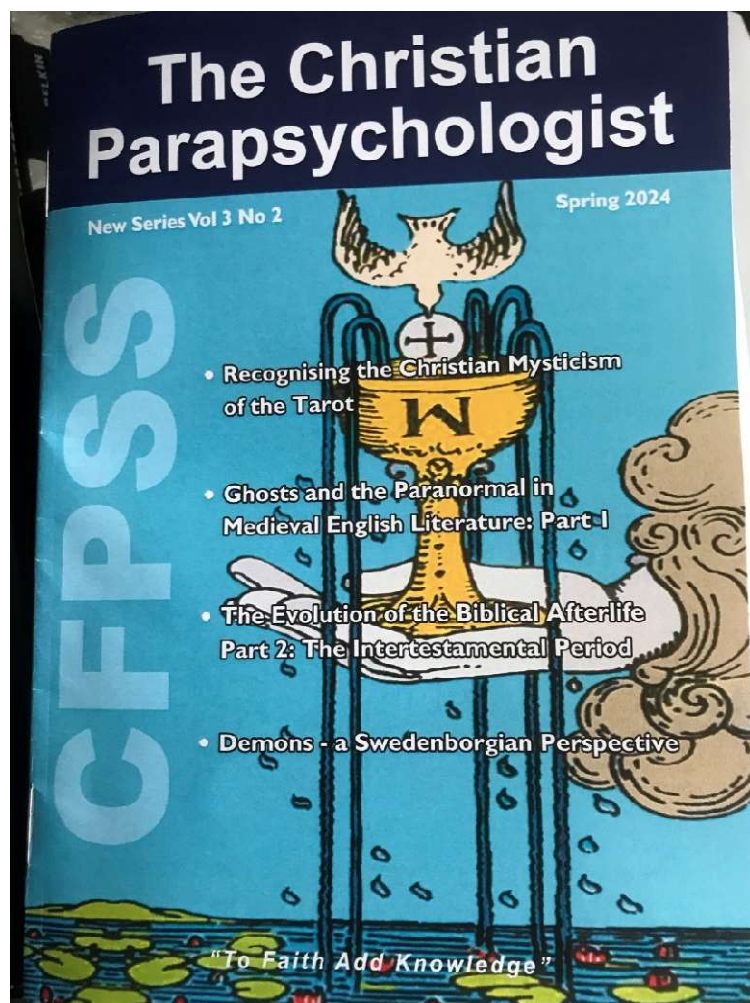
I have had another article published in "The Christian Parapsychologist", which is the journal of the Churches Fellowship for Psychical and Spiritual Studies. It is entitled "Demons - a Swedenborgian Perspective".

In the article I put forward Swedenborg's experiences of demons as fallen human beings. (Many Christians believe that they are fallen angels.) I question whether Satan or the Devil is read into passages in the Bible such as the King of Babylon (Isaiah 14:12-20) and the King of Tyre (Ezekiel 28:12-20) I suggest that domineering egotism lies at the root of such passages in the Bible, and this personality trait is in us, angels and demons. I then talk of demons as having bodies, not only in Swedenborg's visions, but in Near-Death Experiences and After-Death Communications. Finally, I give a few scary descriptions of demons that Swedenborg met.
