Over the course of the past eight months, the Ministry have been working closely with Conference Council with a view to improving the overall structural process we use in the day to day running of our organisation. In order to keep everyone informed going forward, we will be providing regular updates here in E-News regarding future developments. Here are some of the changes we have made so far:

Deputy Spiritual Leader

At our AGM in February, Revd Becky Jarratt was appointed as Deputy Spiritual Leader, which was ratified by Conference Council in March. She will be taking on organisational and administrative aspects to allow Revd Jack Dunion, Spiritual Leader, to focus on spiritual and pastoral areas.

Revd Brian Talbot

Revd Brian Talbot is to be the Minister of Kearsley New Church from 1st May. Brian will continue to tutor courses at SOLCe, but as of 1st May he has stepped down from the role of Secretary of the Committee of Ministers.
