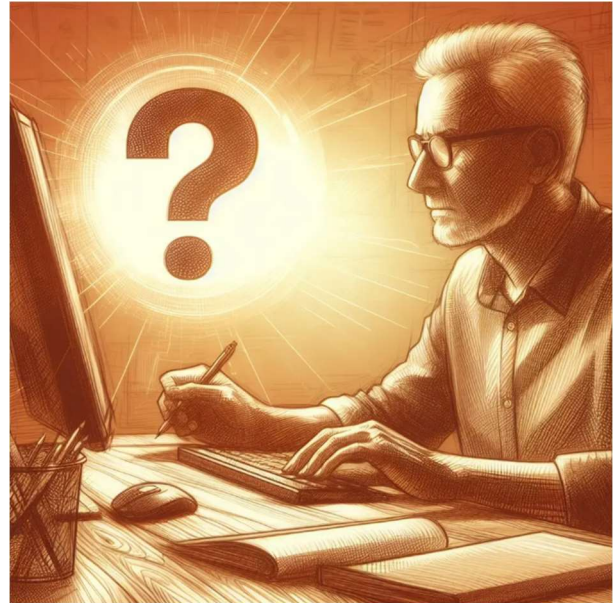
New Christian Bible Study – AI Bot
